Silent Star. The House Un-American Activities Committee finally found a cagey witness after months of search: actress Karen Morley, 41, listed as pro-Communist in testimony by many Hollywood figures. She took the stand to give the usual answer such witnesses always give. She refused to say anything on the Constitutional ground that she might incriminate herself if she did so.

No Exit. The man whose name has become a symbol to a whole generation applied for parole after serving 20 months of his five-year prison term for perjury. The U.S. Parole Board reviewed the case of Alger Hiss, voted unanimously to deny his request for freedom.
