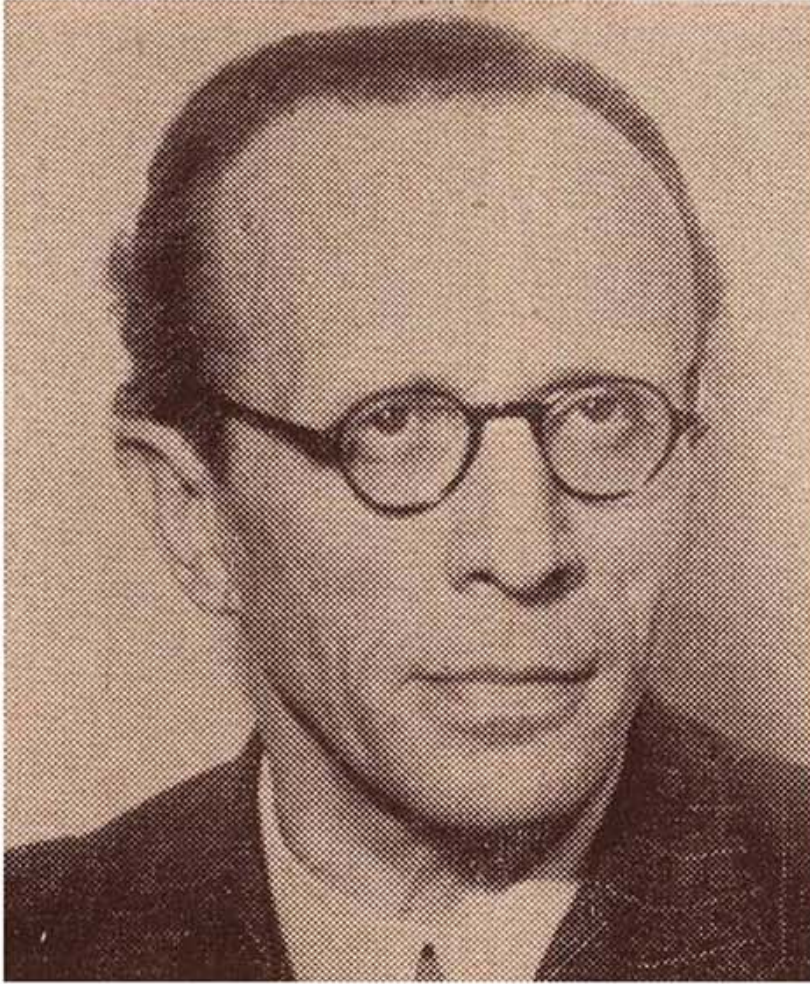

HITLER'S WOLVES

Here's how it all started. Back in 1943, even while struggling against advancing German armies, Russians looked over collection of Nazi generals (trapped on battlefield), and packed most promising off to a Red indoctrination program (the "Antifa" schools).

Focus correspondents in Germany have reached across border into Red zone to get the following cases of former Nazis now training communist hordes:

Colonel Paul Markgraf, one-time commander of 40th Panzer Division; Major General Otto Korfes, once handed Knight's Cross by Hitler; Vincenz Mueller, chief of staff of Hitler's 17th Army Corps; Martin Lattman, commander of Hitler's 14th Panzer Division; Walter Lewess-Litzman, chief of staff of Luftwaffe; General Arno von Lenski.



Ex-Nazi General Vincenz Mueller, responsible for massacre of hundreds of Jews in Poland, is Chief of Staff of "People's Police."

These ex-Nazis are today training East Germany's Red army! This is each man's job:

General Korfes: Chief of Central Archives of the Soviet Zone;

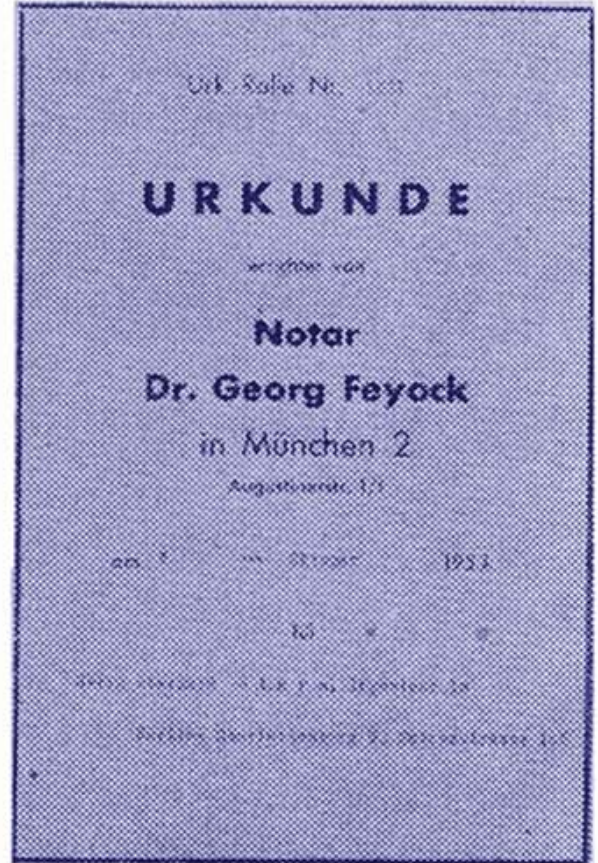
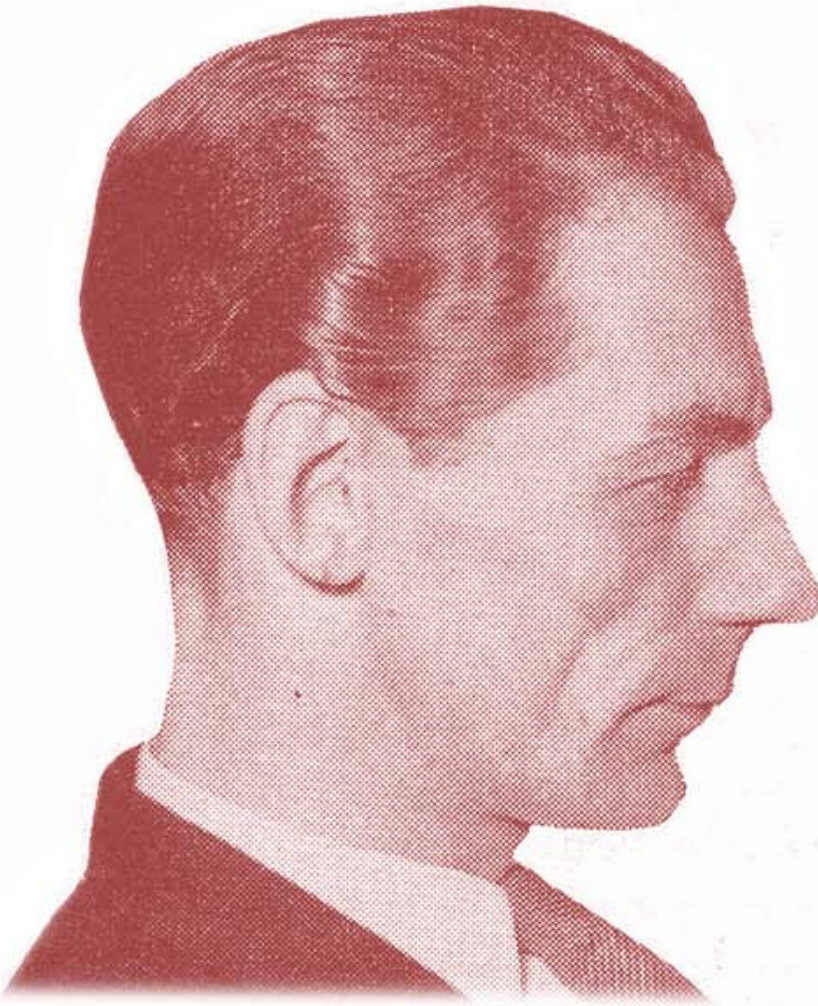
Martin Lattman: Chief of training Red's People's Police;

Walter Lewess-Litzman: chief propagandist of Red German papers, liaison man to former Nazi Army friends in West Germany. Lewess-Litzman is key figure. A contact man of the oily Goebbels school, he recruits, and finances activities of, former Nazis living in Western zones. (Ed. note—see Stern affidavit photo.)

General Arno von Lenski: chief of Red zone's National Democratic party (Hitler's was National Socialist).
