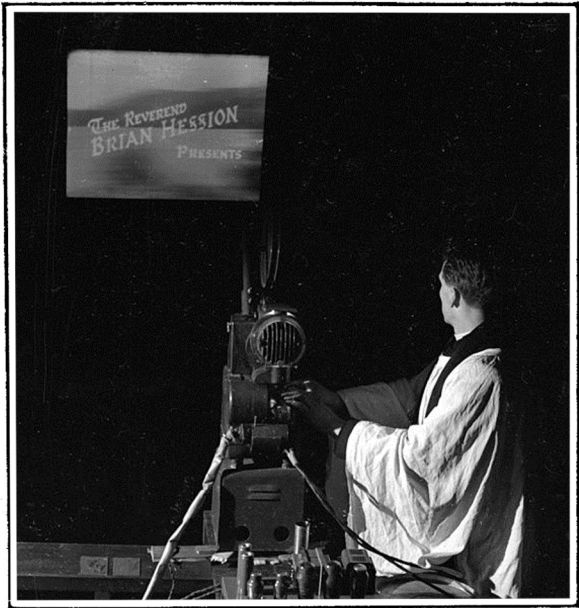

The Reverend Brian Hession

¶ The realization that the movies are full while the churches are empty was the start of a revolutionary idea in the brain of the Rev. Brian Hession, vicar of Holy Trinity Church, Aylesbury, England. Mr. Hession combined the two, and the first religious talking film service, which he conducted in the Metropole Cinema in London a few Sundays ago, attracted a curious audience of 2,000 persons. The service consisted only of a few hymns and an introduction to the film, "The Passing of the Third Floor Back."
